The name SAMEYKI means a team ...

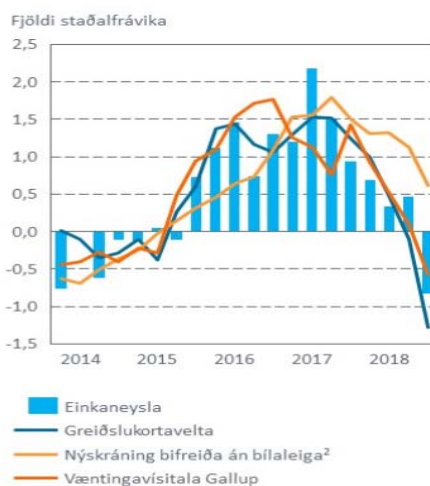
Private consumption and expectations of Icelanders

1. ársfjórðungur 2014 – 4. ársfjórðungs 2018



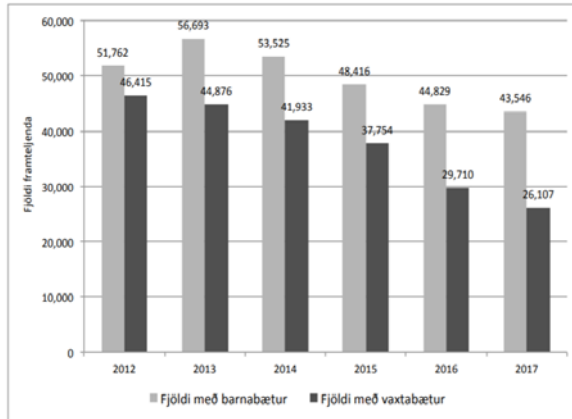

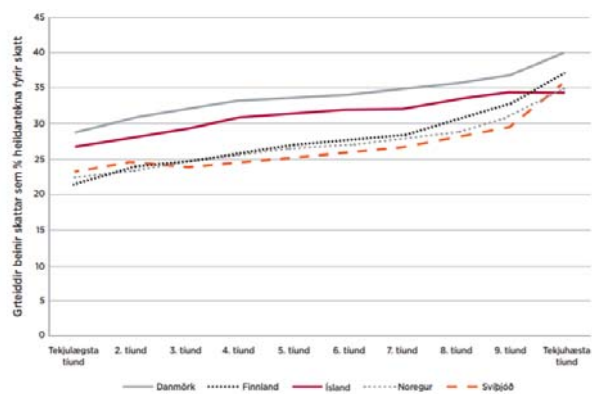
